

Dear Tier One Members:

Thank you to all the neighborhoods that stepped up at the last minute to write letters or presented themselves to Council Chambers to speak in support of the future land use amendments. We were defeated today, but it is not over.

This afternoon, Councilman Trevino filed a CCR to create the changes to the Land Use Plan regarding MF-33 and MF-25. Read the attached CCR

NEXT STEP: ACT NOW

- Contact (write or call) Mayor Nirenberg to fulfil his promise to protect neighborhoods by putting the CCR on the Governance Committee Agenda when it meets later this month.
- Attend Trevino's Press Conference tomorrow, Friday at 3:00 p.m. on the 300 block of West Norwood.
- Immediately contact your Council Member to either thank her or him for their support or protest their decision if they voted against the amendments.
- Ask your Council Member to support neighborhoods by voting for the CCR.

WHAT HAPPENED

Although the Council Members and the Mayor all stated during today's City Council meeting that they supported neighborhoods, the actions of many did not show that support during the final vote. Shaw (2), Viagran (3), Gonzales (5), Brockhouse (6), Palaez (8) and Perry (10) voted against the amendments to the Future Land Use ordinance that would have given neighborhoods some protections. The amendments included moving MF-33 from Medium Density and adding MF-22 to Neighborhood Mixed Use. These amendments would have helped to prevent the incompatible infill developments we are seeing in our neighborhoods. In addition, these amendments would have been additional tools in developing a future neighborhood that would have been conducive to all. These amendments have been part of the official discussion since May.

Those who stood and supported their neighborhoods were: Trevino (D1), Sandoval (D7), Courage (D9), and Saldana (D4). We are grateful for their strength and their desire to protect neighborhoods. Councilman Trevino was a true leader today in challenging the naysayers.

Stand with your neighbors and advocate for the future of your neighborhood and communities. **TAKE ACTION NOW. Call and email the Mayor's office and attend the press conference tomorrow.**
